



I-95 New Haven Harbor Crossing Corridor Improvement Program **CONSTRUCTION NEWS**

April 28, 2010

Closure of East Street between Wooster Street and Forbes Avenue is scheduled to begin on Wednesday, April 28, 2010.

The Connecticut Department of Transportation is announcing that East Street, between Wooster Street & Forbes Avenue, will be closed Wednesday, April 28th & Thursday April 29th, between the hours of 7PM & 6AM. East Street will also be closed weekends from 8PM on Friday & continue to 6AM on Monday, beginning Friday, April 30th & ending the weekend of June 4 - June 7, 2010. These closures are necessary to facilitate the installation of a sanitary sewer.

What to Expect

The map on the reverse side illustrates the area detailed.

- East Street will be closed between Forbes Avenue and Wooster Street. Work will occur on Wednesday, April 28th and Thursday, April 29th between the hours of 7 PM and 6 AM.
- East Street will be closed weekends between Forbes Avenue & Wooster Street. Work will occur between the hours of 8PM on Friday & continue to 6AM on Monday, beginning Friday, April 30th & ending the weekend of June 4 - 7, 2010. Work will not occur Memorial Day weekend.
- Intermittent lane closures on Water Street will also be in effect. One lane of traffic will be maintained in each direction.
- Signs will be posted to help guide you.
- All work will occur weather permitting and will be rescheduled as necessary.

The work in Contract B1 is part of the I-95 New Haven Harbor Crossing (NHHC) Corridor Improvement Program and includes the construction of the new Q-Bridge main span bridge foundations and I-95 Northbound approach structure. The construction will be accomplished 'off line' from I-95 thereby minimizing impacts to interstate traffic. The project is in advance of the construction of the new Pearl Harbor Memorial (Q) Bridge and the I-95 / I-91 / Route 34 Interchange.
