Nighttime Closure of East Street is Scheduled to Begin Monday, April 12, 2010

The Connecticut Department of Transportation is announcing a nighttime closure of East Street between Water and Wooster Streets. This closure will occur Monday, April 12th & continue through Friday, May 7, 2010. This closure is necessary to facilitate steel erection for I-95 northbound over East Street.

What to Expect

The map on the reverse side illustrates the area detailed.

- East Street will be closed Monday through Friday between the hours of 7 PM and 6 AM on Monday, April 12th, through Friday, May 7, 2010.
- Signs will be posted to help guide you.
- Work will occur weather permitting and will be rescheduled, if necessary.

The work in Contract B1 is part of the I-95 New Haven Harbor Crossing (NHHC) Corridor Improvement Program and includes the construction of The Q-Bridge main span bridge foundations and I-95 Northbound approach structure. The construction will be accomplished 'off line' from I-95 thereby minimizing impacts to interstate traffic. The project is in advance of the construction of the new Pearl Harbor Memorial (Q) Bridge and the I-95/I-91/Route 34 Interchange.
