



I-95 New Haven Harbor Crossing Corridor Improvement Program **CONSTRUCTION NEWS**

February 11, 2010

Nighttime lane closures of I-95 in New Haven will occur Monday, February 15th through Thursday, February 18, 2010.

The Connecticut Department of Transportation is announcing that nighttime lane closures and stopping of traffic for 10 minute intervals will occur on I-95 Northbound and Southbound between Kimberly Avenue / Ella T. Grasso Boulevard Interchange (Exit 44) and Long Wharf Drive / Sargent Drive Interchange (Exit 46) in New Haven. The closures will occur between the hours of 12 AM and 5 AM, Monday, February 15, 2010 through Thursday, February 18, 2010. The lane closures and stopping of traffic is required for the installation of a new overhead sign truss spanning I-95 NB and SB. Work will occur weather permitting and will be rescheduled as necessary.

What to Expect

The map on the reverse side illustrates the area detailed.

- Lane closures and stopping of traffic of I-95 NB & SB, between Exits 44 and 46 in New Haven will occur Monday, February 15th, through Thursday, February 18, 2010, between the hours of 12 AM & 5 AM.
- Motorists can expect significant delays in the area of the surrounding Interchange including I-91 and Route 34. Please plan ahead and consider alternate routes to get to your destination.
- Signs will be posted to help guide you.
- Work will occur weather permitting and will be rescheduled, if necessary.

The work in Contract E2 is part of the I-95 New Haven Harbor Crossing (NHHC) Corridor Improvement Program and includes the construction of a new ramp (Route 34 Flyover Bridge) from I-95 NB to Route 34 WB at Exit 47 in New Haven. The project also includes reconstruction of the Route 34 WB bridge over Brewery Street, relocation of the Exit 46 ramps at Long Wharf and Sargent Drives and the construction of a second lane from I-91 SB to I-95 SB. The project is in advance of the construction of the new Pearl Harbor Memorial (Q) Bridge and the I-95/I-91/Route 34 Interchange.
