



I-95 New Haven Harbor Crossing Corridor Improvement Program **CONSTRUCTION NEWS**

Water Street Lane Closure Scheduled for Thursday, February 18, 2010.

The Connecticut Department of Transportation is announcing the right lanes of Water Street in the EB direction near Hamilton and East Streets, will be closed on Thursday, February 18, 2010, between the hours of 9 AM and 3 PM. One lane of traffic in both directions will be maintained. This closure is necessary to facilitate steel erection for the I-95 NB approach to the Q-Bridge.

What to Expect

The map on the reverse side illustrates the area detailed.

- The right lanes of Water Street between Hamilton and East Streets will be closed Thursday, February 18, 2010, between the hours of 9 AM and 3 PM.
- One lane of traffic in each direction will be maintained on Water Street.
- Signs will be posted to help guide you.
- Work will occur weather permitting and will be rescheduled, if necessary.

The work in Contract B1 is part of the I-95 New Haven Harbor Crossing (NICH) Corridor Improvement Program and includes the construction of The Q-Bridge main span bridge foundations and I-95 Northbound approach structure. The construction will be accomplished 'off line' from I-95 thereby minimizing impacts to interstate traffic. The project is in advance of the construction of the new Pearl Harbor Memorial (Q) Bridge and the I-95/I-91/Route 34 Interchange.
