



I-95 New Haven Harbor Crossing Corridor Improvement Program **CONSTRUCTION NEWS**

Nighttime Closure of Water Street is Scheduled to begin Monday, March 1, 2010.

The Connecticut Department of Transportation is announcing that Water Street between Hamilton and East Streets, will be closed weeknights, Monday through Friday, beginning Monday, March 1st through Monday, March 15, 2010, between the hours of 7PM and 6AM. This closure is necessary to facilitate steel erection for the I-95 NB approach to the Q-Bridge.

What to Expect

The map on the reverse side illustrates the area detailed.

- Water Street between Hamilton and East Streets will be closed weeknights, Monday through Friday, beginning Monday, March 1st, through Monday, March 15, 2010, between the hours of 7PM and 6AM.
- Traffic will be detoured onto Long Wharf Drive and Hamilton Street.
- Signs will be posted to help guide you.
- Work will occur weather permitting and will be rescheduled, if necessary.

The work in Contract B1 is part of the I-95 New Haven Harbor Crossing (NICH) Corridor Improvement Program and includes the construction of The Q-Bridge main span bridge foundations and I-95 Northbound approach structure. The construction will be accomplished 'off line' from I-95 thereby minimizing impacts to interstate traffic. The project is in advance of the construction of the new Pearl Harbor Memorial (Q) Bridge and the I-95/I-91/Route 34 Interchange.
