Hamilton Street Closure Scheduled to Begin Monday, February 1st through Friday, February 12, 2010.

Hamilton Street will be closed to thru traffic between Water Street and Long Wharf Drive in New Haven beginning Monday, February 1st, through Friday, February 12, 2010 to facilitate steel erection for the I-95 NB west approach to the Q-Bridge.

Getting Around

The map on the reverse side illustrates the area where the construction will occur and the roadway detours that will be required during the work. Signs will be posted to help guide you.

- The detour will be in effect Monday, February 1st through Friday, February 12, 2010.
- Detour traffic will be rerouted onto Water Street, East Street and Long Wharf Drive.
- Full time two-way traffic will be maintained on Water Street, East Street and Long Wharf Drive.
- All work will occur weather permitting and will be rescheduled if needed.

The work in Contract B1 is part of the I-95 New Haven Harbor Crossing (NHHC) Corridor Improvement Program and includes the construction of The Q-Bridge main span bridge foundations and I-95 Northbound approach structure. The construction will be accomplished 'off line' from I-95 thereby minimizing impacts to interstate traffic. The project is in advance of the construction of the new Pearl Harbor Memorial (Q) Bridge and the I-95/I-91/Route 34 Interchange.
