



I-95 New Haven Harbor Crossing Corridor Improvement Program **CONSTRUCTION NEWS**

Lane Closure of Long Wharf Drive in New Haven is Scheduled through Thursday, May 27, 2010

The Connecticut Department of Transportation is announcing that the right lane of Long Wharf Drive SB will be closed between Hamilton Street & Canal Dock Road. Work will occur through Thursday, May 27, 2010, between the hours of 9 AM and 3 PM. This work is necessary to facilitate bridge construction.

What to Expect:

The map on the reverse side illustrates the area detailed.

- Right lane of Long Wharf Drive will be closed on weekdays through Thursday, May 27, 2010, between the hours of 9 AM and 3 PM. One lane of traffic in both directions will be maintained.
- Signs will be posted to help guide you.
- Work will occur weather permitting and will be rescheduled, if necessary.

The work in Contract E2 is part of the I-95 New Haven Harbor Crossing (NHH) Corridor Improvement Program and includes the construction of a new ramp (Route 34 'Flyover' Bridge) from I-95 NB to Route 34 WB at Exit 47 in New Haven. The project also includes reconstruction of the Route 34 WB bridge over Brewery Street, relocation of the Exit 46 ramps at Long Wharf and Sargent Drives and the construction of a second lane from I-91 SB to I-95 SB. The project is in advance of the construction of the new Pearl Harbor Memorial Bridge (Q-Bridge) and the I-95/I-91/Route 34 Interchange.

The Connecticut Department of Transportation is working to inform local residents of current and upcoming construction activities through bulletins such as this, as well as the I-95 NHH Corridor Improvement Program website (www.i95newhaven.com) and the toll-free Program Hotline (**1-866-277-9595**).
