## **US Route 1/Forbes Avenue Traffic Shift is Scheduled for Thursday, April 15, 2010**

The Connecticut Department of Transportation is announcing that a traffic shift is scheduled to be in effect for US Route 1/Forbes Avenue on Thursday, April 15, 2010 and will be in place for approximately 5 months. The traffic shift will reduce Forbes Avenue from 2 lanes in each direction to 1 lane in each direction from the west side of the Tomlinson Bridge to the Stiles Street intersection. The traffic shift is necessary to facilitate the construction of drilled shafts and retaining wall for the new Q-Bridge.

### **What to Expect**

The map on the reverse side illustrates the area detailed.

- A traffic shift will be in effect on US Route 1/Forbes Avenue beginning on Thursday, April 15, 2010 and will be in place for approximately 5 months.
- The traffic shift will reduce Forbes Avenue from 2 lanes in each direction to 1 lane in each direction from the west side of the Tomlinson Bridge to the Stiles Street intersection.
- Signs will be posted to help guide you.
- Work will occur weather permitting and will be rescheduled, if necessary.

The work in Contract B is part of the I-95 New Haven Harbor Crossing (NHH) Corridor Improvement Program and includes the construction of the new Pearl Harbor Memorial (Q) Bridge.
